Jerome L. Neuner (Jerry) has completed 40 years in higher education as a faculty member. administrator, and consultant. He has the B.A. from Canisius College, the M.A from the SUNY University at Binghamton, and the Ph.D. in Educational Research and Evaluation from the Uni Ov Oe rOsity at Buffalo.

His administrative career was in academics, serving several times as associate dean, acting dean, associate vice president, and acting

vice president. Among his achievements include co-authoring and management of program development and research grants totaling over \$1.5 million from sources such as the Howard Hughes Medical Institute, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the US Department of Education, and the Carnegie Foundation.

His portfolio includes international education, sponsored programs, career center, advising, developmental education, and continuing education. He authored a dozen student exchange agreements with foreign universities. He also served the Middle States Commission on Higher Education as an accreditation team member, reviewer, and evaluator. These services have included both regional and international institutions.

He has held all the leadership positions in AAUA and has chaired the awards committee for 12 years. He has reviewed books for the *Journal of Higher Education Management*. Most recently he is one of the editors of *Ethical Principles for Higher Education Administrators: A Case Study Approach* (AAUA 2019) and was on the committee that revised the AAUA Ethical Principles for College and University Administrators.
